On TV shows and in movies, ghosts look scary and dangerous.

In real life, that's not true. There are *no* documented cases of a ghost killing anyone, ever. Ghosts generally appear as a misty form, reflection or as a healthy, living person. They're still *people*.

Most people live comfortably with the ghosts in their homes.

However, it can be difficult to tell the difference between an angry ghost and a malicious spirit or demon.

If you think that your home or business is haunted and you are very concerned about your safety, put this book down and call a professional immediately.

Remember that ghosts are *spirits*, so a spiritual advisor -- a priest, minister or rabbi -- may have the most experience with this kind of problem... and the best advice. Start there.

If he or she cannot help, ask for a referral or recommendation. There may be a good paranormal investigation team in your area.

If you feel that you are in danger from something in your home, do not stay there. Leave right now.

Get help immediately.
